Most schools in Bexley have an Education Welfare Officer (EWO) from the service attached to them. The role of the Education Welfare Service (EWS) team is to support children, families and schools with school attendance issues including:

- ◆ Internal and External exclusions
- ◆ Reduced Timetables

EWOs work closely with professionals such as:

- ◆ members of the Early Intervention Team
- ◆ social care
- ◆ the SEN department
- ◆ staff working on education inclusion

The EWS team will be able to discuss and answer any questions parents might have.
