To support and empower parent/carers of children and young people (0-25) with SEND, in Bexley, ensuring all parent/carers have their views heard both in relation to their child's needs and to inform the planning and development of services locally and nationally.

- Attending meetings with Bexley Council for the development and provision of services for our children and young people.
- Providing a central parent consultation point for Bexley Council and service providers
- Proactively providing ongoing feedback to service providers on performance
- Raising awareness of the impact of a wide range of special needs on family life
- Providing views, based on personal experiences and canvassed opinion, ensuring that all parents and carers, whatever their background, have the opportunity to have their opinions represented..

- The opportunity to work in a small, friendly, supportive and informal team comprised of Trustees, volunteers, and part time staff.
- The opportunity to influence local authority SEND strategy and its delivery.
