Who is it for?

- **The parents/carers** of young people aged 14 – 24 who have special educational needs and/or disabilities, who are:
 - considering their next steps in terms of education and/or employment, **OR**;
 - not currently in education, employment or training.
- **Young people** with special educational needs and/or disabilities, aged 14-24, as mentioned above.

What is it about?

This event is focused on helping our young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities to plan clear and accessible progression routes from education to employment. It will provide young people and their parents/carers with the opportunity to travel along the 'Preparing for Adulthood journey', with the opportunity to speak with organisations and teams from the different milestones of the transition period between ages 14 - 24. This includes: Support and assessment teams for ages 14+, schools, further education providers, careers advice organisations, supported employment teams and other employment-related organisations.

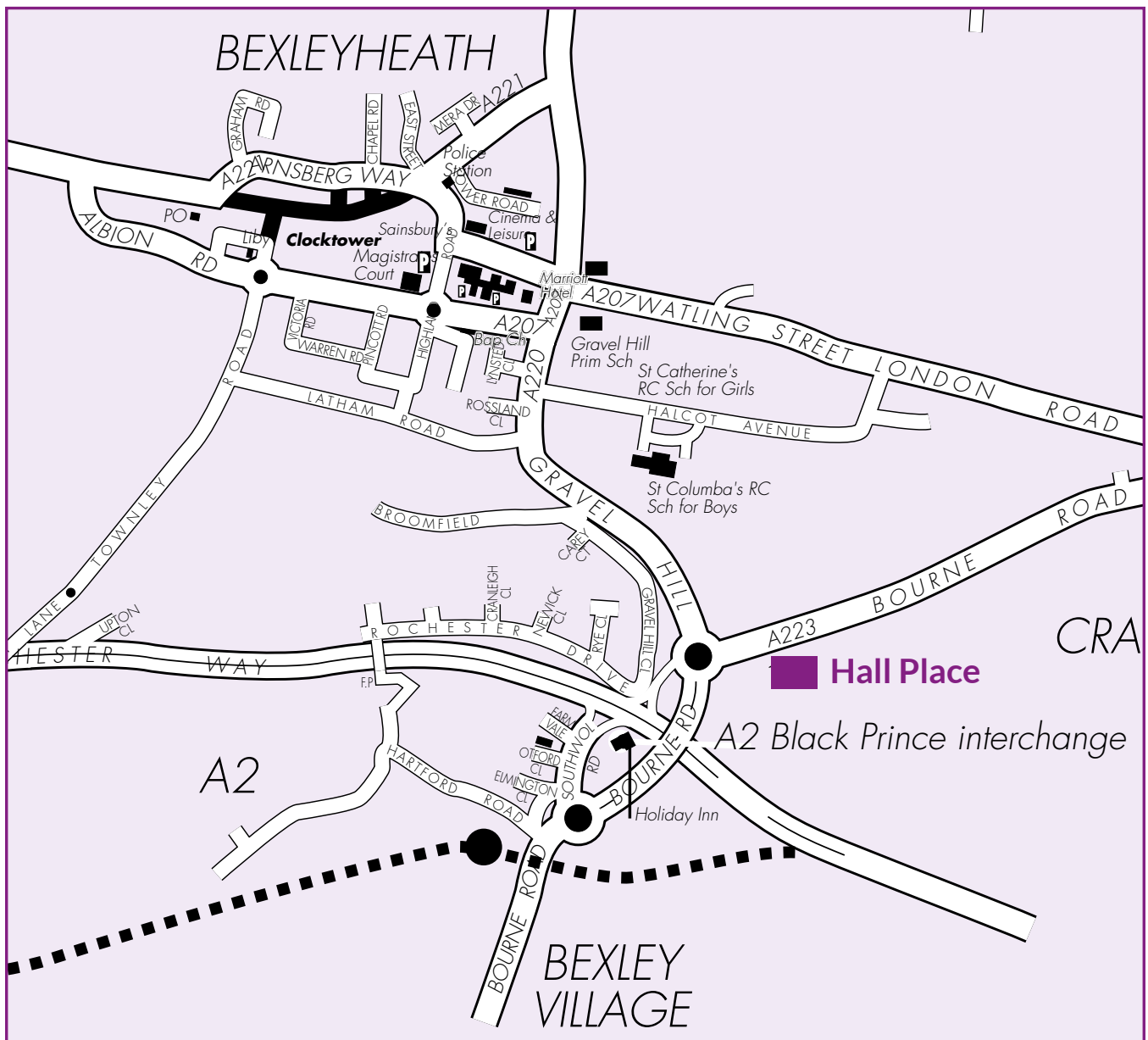
